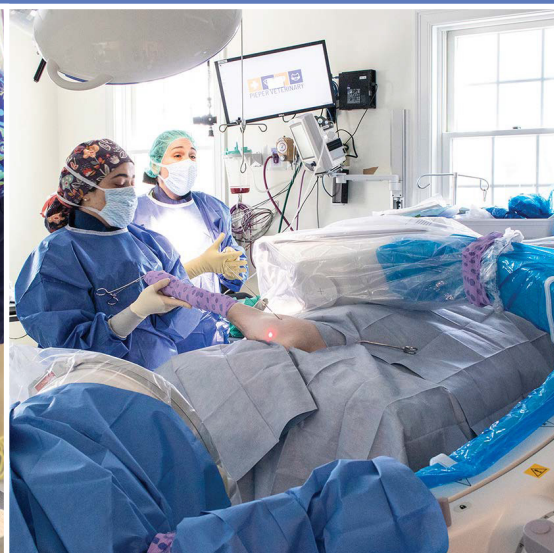




ROTATING INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Approximately 60% of our interns go on to complete additional specialty internships or residencies, while the remaining 40% choose ER, urgent, or primary care. However, thanks to our varied opportunities for employment and our commitment to positive relationships with our employees, we are proud to report that many alumni remain on-staff post internship, or joyfully return as specialists after completing their residency training elsewhere.

Four ER / Specialty Locations

We operate a 24-hour emergency care hospital with 9 specialty departments in Middletown, CT and two 7-day urgent care hospitals (Middletown, CT & Madison, CT). In addition, our Stratford, CT location offers oncology and surgery.

Nine Primary Care Locations

Our locations are located throughout CT, including one that shares the building with our 24-hour hospital.

A Team That's Second to None

Our staff of 350+ includes 23 specialists, 26 ER clinicians, and 27 primary care doctors, along with residents, specialty interns, and rotating interns.

Opportunities

Specialty Internships & Residencies

In our program, we offer specialty internships in Critical Care, Internal Medicine, Neurology, Avian/Exotics and Surgery. In addition, we offer residencies in Surgery and Neurology.

Primary Case Responsibility

With the support of a full range of specialists and experienced emergency doctors, interns take hands-on diagnostic and treatment responsibility.

Direct Feedback

During hospital-wide rounds each morning, interns present case transfers to specialists and general practitioners and receive feedback on diagnostics and management.

Evaluations

Every intern is evaluated regularly in the areas of professional performance, communication skills, and progress in the pursuit of knowledge and clinical aptitude.

Requirements

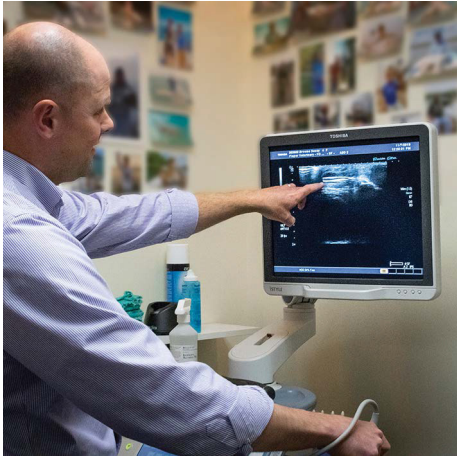
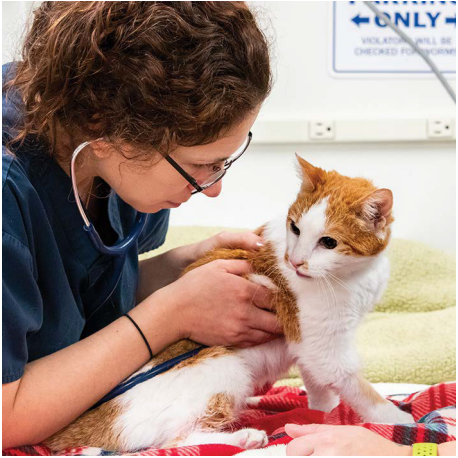
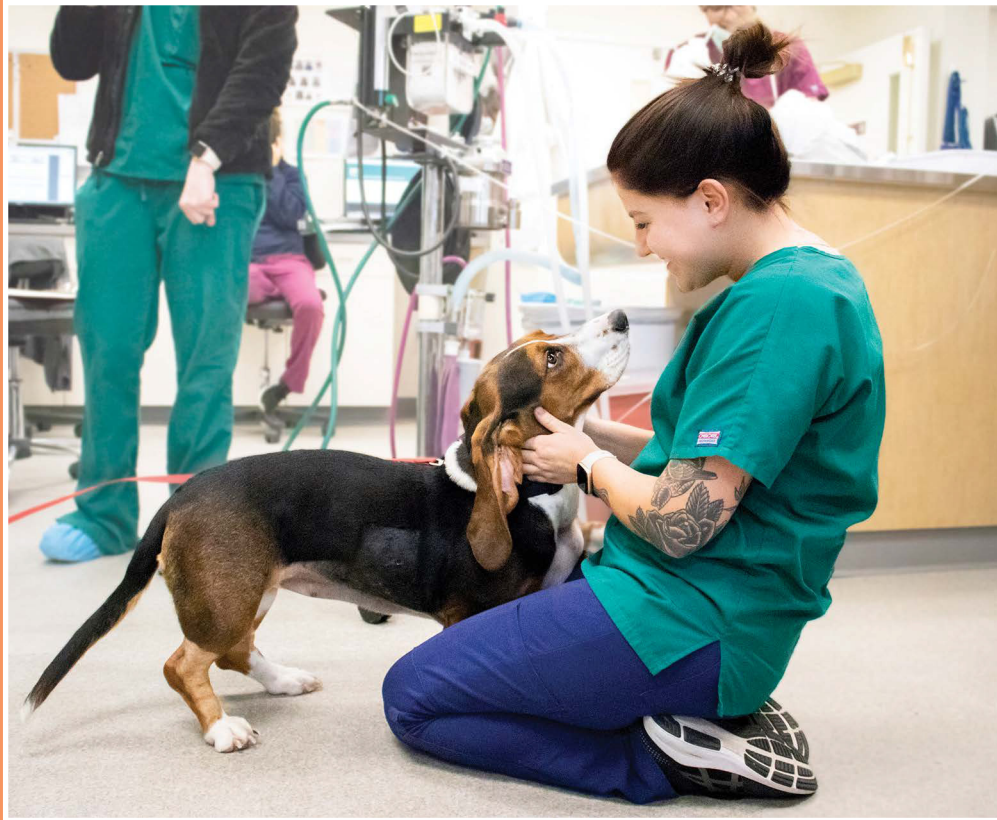

Internal Medicine

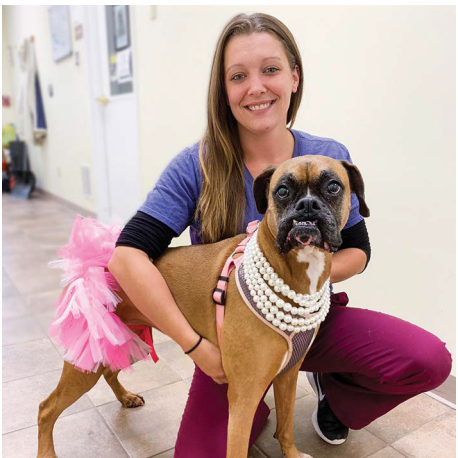
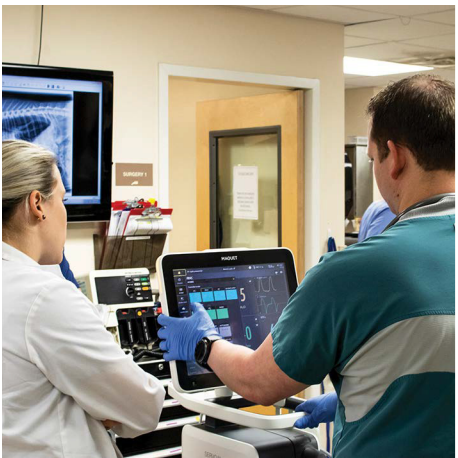
A variety of complex cases are managed in-hospital and by appointment. Interns enjoy a comprehensive, multimodal approach to diagnosis, intervention, and chronic care while being exposed to management strategies. They also perform procedures such as endoscopy, bronchoscopy, colonoscopy, and rhinoscopy.

Neurology & Neurosurgery

As one of the most highly regarded neurology services in New England, we have a large caseload of surgical and medical patients. Under the guidance of three boarded specialists, interns hone their neuroanatomic diagnoses while gaining experience in complex neurosurgical procedures.

Diagnostic Imaging

We provide ultrasound, radiography, fluoroscopy, and CT support for Pieper hospitals and our referring veterinary community. Working with a boarded radiologist, this caseload allows interns to solidify their diagnostic interpretation skills while learning more about advanced imaging.



Emergency Care

Certified by VECCS as a Level I Emergency & Critical Care Facility, our ER is open 24/7 and sees a high caseload. Overseen by 3-4 staff doctors per day plus critical care specialists, rotating interns get the opportunity for primary case responsibility while working alongside and with the support of senior staff doctors.

Critical Care

Providing in-hospital care for our most critical patients, RACC takes transfers directly from the ER and supports the specialty teams with dynamic cases. Under our board-certified criticalists and support team, interns utilize modalities such as mechanical ventilation, telemetry, and high-flow nasal oxygen.

General Surgery

Our boarded surgeons, residents, and specialty interns manage a high-volume caseload of soft tissue and orthopedic procedures. Interns gain primary surgical experience through procedures performed through the emergency and primary care departments.

Oncology

Overseeing a wide variety of cases, this department works closely with our surgical and imaging teams. With the support of two boarded oncologists and technical staff, interns gain valuable experience in diagnosing cancers and selecting the best treatment method for each patient while tracking progress and outcomes.

Avian & Exotics

We treat a broad variety of species on emergency, referral, and primary care bases. Interns practice primary case responsibility for medical and surgical cases in various animal taxa, with supervision provided by a board-certified specialist, a dedicated technical team, and a specialty intern.

Anesthesia

Our experienced veterinary anesthesiologists provide comprehensive individualized anesthesia and pain management support across a wide range of procedures, from routine surgeries to complex specialty and emergency cases, including the perioperative period. Working closely with surgeons, emergency clinicians, and other specialty teams, our anesthesia team helps ensure safe, effective care for patients with varying levels of anesthetic risk.

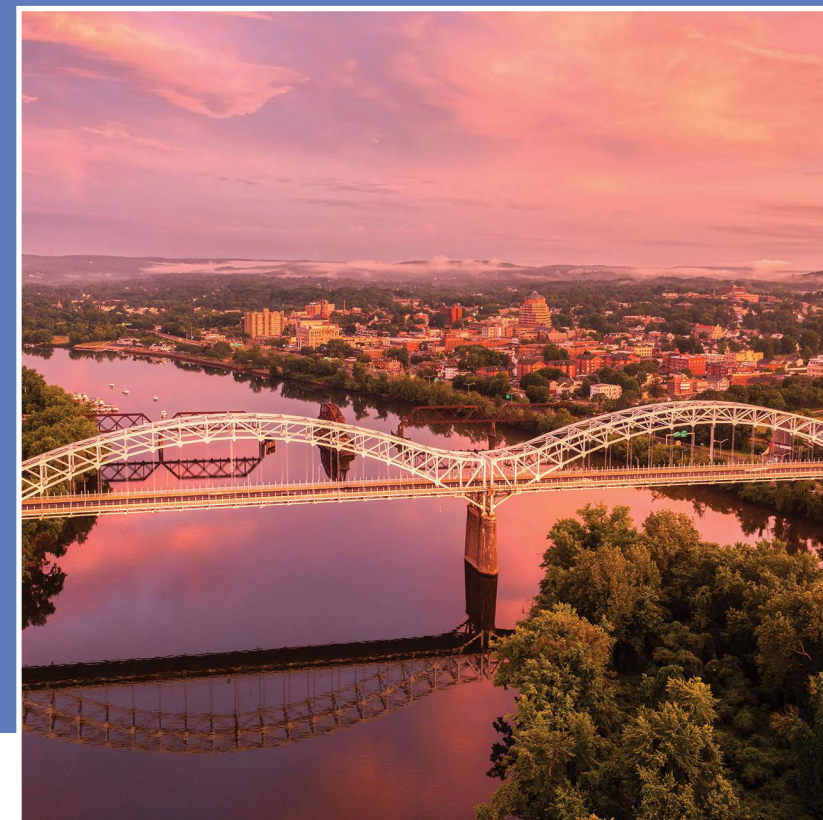
LIVING IN CONNECTICUT
